

## **ORDINANCE 938**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE 5 OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE CENTRAL CITY MUNICIPAL CODE; TO REPEAL ALL OTHER CONFLICTING ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CENTRAL CITY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Chapter 2, Section 2-504, of the Central City Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

### **SECTION 2-504: OFFENSES: WEEDS, LITTER**

It shall be unlawful for the owner or occupant of any lot or piece of ground within the zoning jurisdiction of the City to allow the growth of twelve inches (12”) or more in height of weeds, grasses or worthless vegetation, or to allow the throwing, depositing or accumulation of litter except in proper receptacles.

It shall be unlawful to permit or maintain any growth of eight inches or more in height of weeds, grasses or worthless vegetation on any lot or piece of ground located within the corporate limits of the City during any calendar year if, within the same calendar year, the City has, pursuant to this section, acted to remove weeds, grasses or worthless vegetation exceeding twelve inches in height on the same lot or piece of ground and had to seek recovery of the costs and expenses of such work from the owner.

Section 2. Any other ordinance or section passed and approved prior to passage, approval, and publication of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions is repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
