

RESOLUTION 2004-9

A RESOLUTION APPROVING WATER RATES FOR THE CITY OF CENTRAL CITY, NEBRASKA

WHEREAS, the City of Central City, Nebraska owns and operates a water distribution system in order to provide for the health and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, City Ordinance provides for rates for water service to be adjusted from time to time by Resolution

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of Central City that the water fees/rates for the City of Central City, Nebraska are hereby established below.

MUNICIPAL WATER DEPARTMENT RATES

All water furnished by the City of Central City and billed beginning May 1, 2004 shall be charged to the customer as follows:

Billing will be done monthly based on the following rates:
