

RESOLUTION 2007-18

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2007 Mayor Clayton Erickson did declare the property at 1411 11th Street to be maintained as a public nuisance; and

WHEREAS, on April 25, 2007, notice of said Nuisance Declaration was personally served to John McDonald by Lieutenant Dierks; and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2007 the City Council of the City of Central City did pass a motion setting a Hearing to determine the existence of a Public Nuisance at 1411 11th Street for July 9, 2007 which was subsequently held over for reconsideration on August 13, 2007; and

WHEREAS, notice of said Hearing was served upon John McDonald by personal service by Lieutenant Dierks on June 14, 2007; and

WHEREAS, after public hearing, the City Council of the City of Central City does find that the property at 1411 11th Street is being maintained as a Public Nuisance contrary to the Municipal Code of the City of Central City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Central City, County of Merrick, State of Nebraska as follows:

- 1) The property at 1411 11th Street is being maintained as a Public Nuisance contrary to the Central City Municipal Code.
- 2) Said nuisance upon said property includes a red semi-trailer with Chevy cab, silver Pontiac Firebird, black Nissan pickup, aluminum V-type boat on wheels, brown Oldsmobile car, several dismantled mowers and bicycles, canning jars, lawn chairs, metal wash tubs, scrap metal and miscellaneous debris.
- 3) The owner(s) is/are given thirty (30) days to bring the property into conformance with the Nuisance Ordinances.
- 4) That after 30 days the City shall abate said nuisance and keep an itemized account of the expenses involved in abating the nuisance.
