

ORDINANCE 885

AN ORDINANCE CREATING STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 2006-2 IN THE CITY OF CENTRAL CITY, NEBRASKA; ORDERING THE CONSTRUCTION OF STREET IMPROVEMENTS THEREIN; ORDERING PUBLICATION OF NOTICE; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CENTRAL CITY, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is created in the City of Central City, Nebraska, a Street Improvement District to be known and designated as Street Improvement District No. 2006-2 of the City of Central City, Nebraska.

Section 2. That the outer boundaries of Street Improvement District No. 2006-1 shall include all of the following described property to wit:

Starting at the northwest corner of Lot One (1), Block Two (2), LPC III Addition; thence eastward to the northeast corner of Lot Eight (8), Block One (1), LPC III Addition; thence southward to the southeast corner of Lot Five (5), Block One (1), LPC III Addition; thence westward to the southwest corner of Lot Three (3), Block Two (2); thence northward to the point of beginning.

And within which district, the following street(s) shall be improved by concrete pavement with integral curb, gutter and all necessary appurtenances related thereto:

12th Avenue from 19th Street to 20th Street

Section 3. Said street(s) shall be improved and said improvements shall be made in accordance with the plans, specifications and estimate prepared by the Special Engineers for the City and to be approved by the Mayor and City Council. The cost of such paving excepting street intersection(s) shall be assessed against the property within said district specifically benefited thereby in proportion to benefits.

Section 4. Notice of creation of said District shall be published as provided by law in the Central City Republican-Nonpareil, a legal newspaper published in and of general circulation in Central City, Nebraska, for two consecutive weeks.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
