

ORDINANCE 887

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTED BY THE CITY OF CENTRAL CITY, NEBRASKA TO AMEND CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 4 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE, FOWLS, RUNNING AT LARGE, PROHIBITION; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Section 1) That Chapter 2, Article 4, Section 2-404 of the Municipal Code of the City of Central City be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2-404: FOWLS, RUNNING AT LARGE, PROHIBITION

It shall be unlawful for any person to allow poultry, chickens, turkeys, geese or any other fowls to run at large within the corporate limits, except in enclosed places on private property.

In the event of a Public Health Emergency, as determined by the Mayor, a prohibition against the keeping, housing, selling, or auctioning of wild or domestic chickens, ducks, geese, or any other fowl within the primary policing jurisdiction of Central City may be enacted. The prohibition shall be made in writing by the Mayor and posted at City Hall. The prohibition shall stay in effect until such time that the Mayor, in writing, lifts the prohibition.

Section 2) That all ordinances and parts of ordinances passed and approved prior to the passage and approval of this ordinance and in conflict therewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3) That this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form according to law.
