

ORDINANCE NO. 891

AN ORDINANCE CREATING SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION DISTRICT NO. 2006-1 OF THE CITY OF CENTRAL CITY, NEBRASKA; ESTABLISHING THE OUTER BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT; DESIGNATING THE SIZE, LOCATION AND TERMINAL POINTS, REFERRING TO THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND ESTIMATE OF THE ENGINEER IN CONNECTION THEREWITH ON FILE WITH THE CITY CLERK

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CENTRAL CITY, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and Council of the City of Central City, Nebraska, hereby find and determine that it is necessary and advisable to extend the municipal sanitary sewer service to beyond the existing system by the construction of certain sanitary sewers, together with all necessary appurtenances thereto, and for the purpose of constructing said improvements there is hereby created Sanitary Sewer Extension District No. 2006-1 of the City.

Section 2. The outer boundaries of Sanitary Sewer Extension District No. 2006-1, shall include all of the following property to-wit:

The East ½ of Lot 25 located in Section 16, Township 13, Range 6 in Merrick County, Nebraska.

Section 3. The sewers to be constructed in said District shall be sanitary sewers along with manholes and all other necessary appurtenances required to complete the project. The size, location and terminal points of said sewers are as follows:

A 10" sanitary sewer main commencing from approximately 145 feet East of the East ½ of Lot 25, extending approximately 245 feet to the West.

Section 4. The plans and specifications for the sewer extension has been prepared by the special engineers for the City, by order of the Mayor and Council of the City pursuant to a resolution duly passed by the City Council, together with the engineer's estimate of the total cost of the proposed extension, have heretofore been filed with the City Clerk and the same are hereby accepted.

It is hereby found and determined that none of the properties included within the foregoing district is served by the existing sewer system of the City and the land included within the District is located within the boundaries of the City or within one mile of the City limits.

Section 5. The engineer's estimate of the total cost of the projects is \$9,000.
