

ORDINANCE 969

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1-1101 TO THE CENTRAL CITY MUNICIPAL CODE; TO REPEAL ALL OTHER CONFLICTING ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CENTRAL CITY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Chapter 1, Section 1-1101, of the Central City Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1-1101: OFFICERS

Five persons shall constitute the Authority. The five members shall be selected by the Mayor and approved by the City Council. At least one member of the Authority shall be a duly elected member of the City Council. In the event that such member's term as City Council member expires, the Mayor shall appoint a current member of the City Council to fill such vacancy. The Mayor shall designate the term of office for each member, as provided in Neb. Rev. Stat. Sections 18-2102.01. The Authority shall select one of its members as chair and one as vice chair. A total of three members of the Authority shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The Authority shall adopt rules for the transaction of its business, and shall keep records of its resolutions, transactions, findings and determinations, which records shall be made available for public inspection during regular business hours.

Section 2. Any other ordinance or section passed and approved prior to passage, approval, and publication of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions is repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
